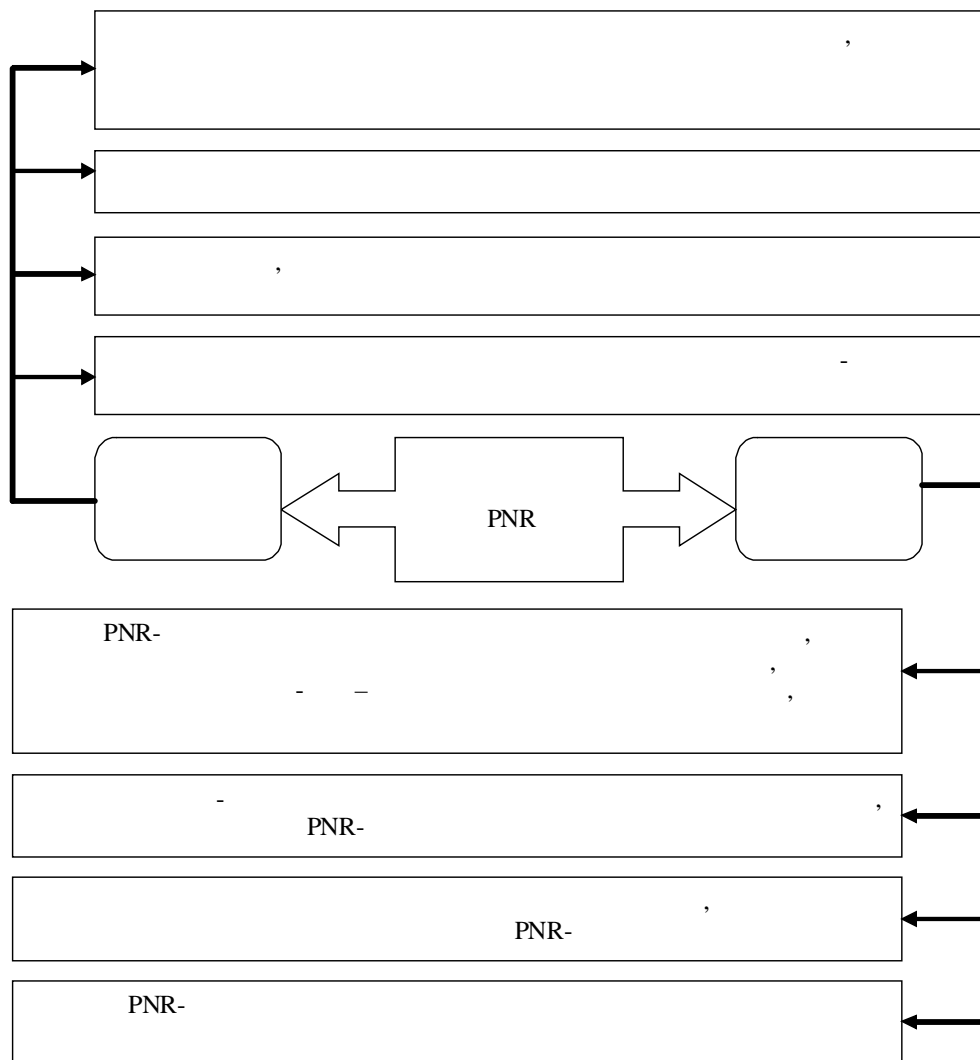

This article explores the key dominant organizing the collection, processing and transfer of PNR-data on passengers, which is used in air ports operators of aircraft safety in the context of the organization of transportation and combating terrorism. Analysis of common and distinctive features of the system prior notification and registration system for passengers found issues that hinder their global implementation, outlines opportunities for more active use of the international community to enhance global and national security. Passenger registration records (PNRs) are the common name of records made by aircraft explants or their agents for each reservation made by the alleged passenger. States have begun to require airlines to provide PNR data, since this information is considered important for assessing the level of threat that can be determined by analyzing such data, in particular in the fight against terrorism. Information PNR is formed on the basis of the data arriving on all segments of the flight within a particular trip. PNR data are collected by operators for commercial and operational purposes in the implementation of air transport services. The lack of uniformity in PNR systems can adversely affect the viability of the air transport industry and reduce the effectiveness of using such data for the purposes for which they are intended. Therefore, it is necessary for states to standardize globally their data requirements and their formats for the electronic transfer of PNR data.
