Summary

Voznyak St.V. Martin Heidegger about Essential of Thinking. The article describes the basic intrinsic dimension of Heidegger’s concept of essential thinking by contrasting "reflection that comprehends" and "thinking that calculates. Intrinsic feature of thinking Heidegger sees in such activities of human beings, which co-operates with entity’s essence, this listening to human’s essence (not intelligence) in overt, which makes something with human, puts him in its own essence and the essence of being.
