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Summary

Blyznyuk Roman. V.V.Zenkovsky's Antropological Paradigms in History of Russian Philosophy. The author analyzes the history of Russian philosophy development investigated by V. V. Zenkovsky in the lidht of philosophical anthropology. Issues of religious aiming approaches of the above mentioned philosopher are actualized. The conclusion about independent nature of philosophical views of Russian thinkers is substantiated. Leading approaches such as moral aiming, cordocentrism, the idea of All-Unity, conciliarism, comprehensive knowledge, mystical comprehension of religions faith are emphasized. 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Summary

Pashkova Oksana. Historical and Philosophical Views of V.Lypynsky in the Context of a Problem of Socio-Political Consolidation. The article deals with the views of the prominent Ukrainian thinker, politician Vyacheslav Lypynsky on the problem of Ukrainian social and political consolidation. As many of his ideas have not lost its relevance to the current stage of Ukrainian state development, the purpose of the article is to clarify the factors for consolidation pointed out by V.Lypynsky and to assess their unification potential. The author notes that the main condition for the Ukrainian statehood, which the thinker believed in, was the unity - religious, regional, political, national, organizational, and a state was generally considered to be a source of national unity. It is noted that religion as an organic element of social organization is able to maintain its authority and consolidate people. The equal importance of elite as the other factor of consolidation is considered. The author argues that a consolidation function of modern Ukrainian elite remains unrealized. Analyzing V.Lypynsky's idea of monarchism the author suggests that it does not have a classical form, whereas V.Lypynsky admitted that the state should have representative bodies. It is emphasized that the thinker recognized consolidating potential of a hereditary monarch, but the national idea filled with territorial patriotism is considered to be the most powerful consolidation factor. A solution to the problem of consolidation in modern Ukraine requires a comprehensive research. However, an incorporation of V.Lypynsky's scientific work results is admitted as an undeniable fact.
