Summary

Solonko Leonid. About the Project of Apophatic Anthropology. The author justifies the need for draft of apophatic anthropology as a tool to remove contradictions between the universal and particular dimensions of human nature. The article distinguishes at least four stages of adaptation through which human activity has gone on the ways of interaction with the existential experience - from the formation of mythology as certain specialized form of early man's activity to attempts of a grand rationalistic assimilation of whole volume of human spirituality in modern times, when the compensatory mechanisms of interacting between the existential and activity essences of human exhausted themselves. The realization of this project involves the addition of some experience of being human, which is open to using special practices, to a scientific corpus of knowledge about the man. Project "apophatic anthropology" focuses on the need to reach the organic synthesis of two beginnings of human - nonactive, "numinous" experience and activity, that creates a new unity, which provided self-determination of man in front of the face of eternity.
