- 2. При проведенні наукових досліджень приділяти особливу увагу розвитку та удосконаленню методичної бази судової експертизи.
- 3. Уважати актуальним упровадження єдиних підходів при проведенні судових експертиз із використанням сучасних науково-технічних досягнень.
- 4. Здійснювати планування наукових розробок відповідно до потреб судово-слідчої та експертної практики з урахуванням сучасних досягнень науки й техніки, а також змін у законодавстві.
 - 5. Розширяти міжнародне співробітництво в галузі судової експертизи.
- 6. Рекомендації розіслати всім судово-експертним установам системи Міністерства юстиції України для врахування в роботі.

On 14–16 September 2017 in Palanga (Centre of recreation and rehabilitation "Pušynas", Palanga, Lithuania) was held XIIIth International scientific practical conference "Criminalistics and forensic expertology: science, studies, practice".
