


of enterprise institutional environment and develop measures for its improvement. **Methods:** Induction and deduction, comparative analysis and synthesis, scientific abstraction. **Results:** Institutional environment of economic security is characterized by predominance of informal institutions over formal ones which create institutional barriers preventing formation of preventive mechanisms of the enterprise protection against external and internal threats. Hence, there is a need to develop effective ways for improving institutional environment of economic security formation which take into account the peculiarities of its development at the micro level, the most important of which should become the measures of legal, organizational and economic character, as well as of resourceful, functional, social, psychological and informational character. **Conclusion:** Imperfections of the institutional environment create risks and threats for the industrial and economic activity of enterprises, which requires activation of the rationalization of its environment in terms of formation of the enterprise economic security on the micro level. The implementation of the proposed measures will ensure the rationalization of the institutional environment of economic security and will enhance the level of the enterprise ability to form preventive mechanisms of protection against internal and external threats.
