Participation of Sweden in regional co-operation of Scandinavian countries in 1990–2000's

The article explores the relationship of Sweden with countries of the region in 1990–2000's and new initiatives of Nordic Cooperation in this period.

L.Voronkov [1], K.Voronov [2], A.Tunander [4], K.Bohme [6], A.Peterson [11], T.Scholz [13], T.Stoltenberg [14] and others are turning their attention to the question of the role and participation of Sweden in cooperation with the Nordic countries in 1990–2000. Research of these authors focuses on the development of cooperation between the Nordic countries in the last two decades and shows the place and role of Sweden in this integration process. However, in the historiography of the problem does not take into account the new concept of Nordic cooperation, the

specific impact of the EU at Nordic cooperation and considers the expansion of Swedish cooperation with countries surrounding regions over the last two decades.

Therefore, this article attempts to analyze the role and participation of Sweden in the integration of the North in the 90-ies XX – beginning of XXI century, to demonstrates the effectiveness of new initiatives of cooperation in Northern Europe and shows the new key vectors multifaceted cooperation between the Nordic countries.
