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### **Disclaimer Reunion: Causes declaration of a separate state in Western Ukraine in 1918**

An analysis of source documents of an official nature, materials, periodicals and sources of personal origin that are directly related to coverage reasons proclamation in 1918 a separate state for Western. Particular attention is paid to the documents and materials that reflect the views of various political parties and individual activists united on Ukraine. The basic factors that directly influenced the development of the national liberation movement in Western Ukraine. Established that the decisive influence on the wake of the Ukrainian people to independent political life had the First World War and especially the revolution of 1917 in Russia and 1918 in the Austro–Hungarian Empire. It is shown that the unstable political situation in the Dnieper, training antyhetmanske rebellion and the prospect of regime change in Ukrainian State made the Western leadership of the national liberation movement to

postpone the issue of unification of all Ukrainian lands into a unified state in the background and declare a separate Ukrainian nation–state in the West lands. However, despite this, the idea of unity of Ukraine remained to be one of the biggest in the Ukrainian national liberation movement.
