Historiography of a problem of a slave trade and its cancellation in English colonies (the second half of XVIII – the first third of the XIX century)

The author sets as the purpose the analysis, generally to an English historiography of abolitionist movement. It is claimed that it is impossible to consider it without studying by researchers of a question of a slave trade and numerous attempts of its cancellation. The conclusion that is present at Vorontsovsky fund not casual, but systematic selection of editions for the problems which have been directly connected with fight against a slave trade and especially with cancellation of slavery of Africans is defended.
