**Role of brotherhoods in development of parish schools in Left-bank Ukraine in the second half – the beginning of the XX century**

Article is devoted to the analysis of activity of Orthodox Church brotherhoods of Left-bank Ukraine in the sphere of support and arrangement of parish schools in the second half of XIX – the beginning of the XX century. Fixed assets of assistance to development and functioning of a network of schools are analysed. As the component religious educational to the direction of work of Orthodox Church brotherhoods of Left-bank Ukraine is considered material support of pupils and teachers of parish schools. Means which allocated orthodox brotherhoods of Left-bank Ukraine made only small percent from the general amount of financial receipts in interests of church schools. However thanks to activity of Orthodox Church brotherhoods the maintenance of tens church schools.
