Organizaciyno–pravovi and administrative–territorial aspects of forming of system of the hitler of occupation vehicle of power are on the walks of life of Raykhskomisariat «Ukraine» (1941–1944)

The problems of organizational and legal operation of the Nazi occupation regime in Ukraine. Author found that the first German authorities, who had to start forming government in the occupied territories of Ukraine, became Feld commandant of Wehrmacht. These combined administrative bodies, other than military objectives and tactical level and ensure that the rear of Army Group «South» were involved in

the organization of local authorities, as well as debug control over their work. After the transfer of the relevant areas of civil administration Rayhskomisariat «Ukraine» military commandant's offices remained in the same territory, but were engaged exclusively with military and tactical.

Civil Administration Rayhskomisariatu «Ukraine» was presented to the management of the commissioners and hebtskomisariars. There are also intermediate layer of management, including hauptkomisariat. The successful management of the respective territories was created hebtskomisariars representation as to control certain sectors of economic activity – representative sections of the Commissioner.

Military and civilian occupation administration tried to keep in pristine condition prior administrative–territorial system. However, the local people and the leadership of local governments sought to partially modify and improve its organizational and legal forms.

Reality has made some changes in administrative practice of the occupation authorities. Refinement and delineation of new boundaries, formation of districts and local community initiatives have resulted in a correlation established administrative affiliation of individual settlements.
