External factors are the religious conflict in Volhynia in 1941–1944

The article deals with the religious life in Volhynia during Second World War. Shown conditions for the existence of the Orthodox Church in the Polish lands after their transition into the German General Government and the USSR. Analysis of attitudes towards Orthodoxy nazi and Soviet authorities. The features of Soviet religious policy in Volhynia during 1939–1941s. Attention is focused on the activity of the Moscow Patriarchate in Western Ukraine. Displaying circumstances that led to the emergence of a split between the church and the process of the two faiths: Autonomous Orthodox Church and the Ukrainian Autocephalous Orthodox Church. It is shown that the impact of the activities of AOC and UAOC religious policy of Soviet and nazi occupation regime encouraged hostility between church. Deals with the controversy between the churches and how they discredit the opposite side.

Shown as a struggle between the churches became political significance and ended the persecution of priests–autonomists individual units of the UPA.
