

TELEVISION IN MODERN LIFE

(level - intermediate)

Author of this lesson plan applies active methods for the practical study of the language: team forms of learning, dramatization, group interaction and reflection. Students acquire knowledge, necessary for their future profession, satisfaction of students' cognitive interests and self-education. The offered lesson motivates students to master the language and has a bright emotional background.

Key words: group work; presentation; acting; individual performance; communicative task; goal setting; knowledge and reflection

Type of class: the class of integrated use of know-ledge

Objectives: to develop speaking skills; to teach students' to express their opinion on the given topic; to develop students' skills in extensive listening; to improve students' abilities in team work; to activate vocabulary; to deepen students' knowledge about television; to promote students' creativity and imagination.

Equipment: smart board, handouts with different activities for the students, videos, a poster, pictures from TV shows

Procedure

Beginning

Teacher. Dear students! Today we are going to speak about television in modern life. Nowadays we can't imagine our life without it. Television influences our minds, changes our views, sometimes makes us learn and seek for more information. For people television is a source of information and a way of spending leisure time.

Brainstorming

A video from the BBC channel «Emma Watson on BBC Blue Peter show is making Christmas cards».

The students answer the teacher's questions about the TV program:

- 1. Who is this girl?
- 2. What are they making?
- 3. What do you think who the viewers of this program are?

The teacher tells the students about the program: Blue Peter is a British children's TV currently shown live on the CBBC television channel. It was first aired in 1958 and is the longest-running children's TV show in the world. It features different aspects such as culture, meeting celebrities, arts and crafts makes, indoor and outdoor activities and pet-caring.

Listening

Before listening pay attention to the questions you should answer then:

What is the text about?

What are the types of programs shown on TV? What can the whole family watch together?

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tective stories. It stars Benedict Cumber batch as Sherlock Holmes and Martin Freeman as Doctor John Watson. Thirteen episodes have been produced, with four three-part series and a special episode.

Student 2: Game of Thrones is an American fantasy drama television series created by David Benioff and D. B. Weiss. It is filmed in Belfast and elsewhere in the United Kingdom, Canada, Croatia, Iceland, Malta, Morocco, Spain, and the United States. Game of Thrones has attracted record viewer ship on HBO and has a broad, active, international fan base. It has been acclaimed by critics, particularly for its acting, complex characters, story, scope, and production values.

Student 3: The Naked Chef, no, there will not be a naked cook on the screen. «Naked» he is named because the host of the programs sincerely and openly shares his skills in front of the audience. Here are some tips from James Oliver:

if you cannot find any ingredient, skip it or replace it. Still will be delicious.

Student 4: The X Factor is a British reality music competition to find new singing talent. The contestants are aspiring singers drawn from public auditions. The show began in 2004 and has since aired annually from August/September until December. The show is produced by Talkback Thames and Cowell's production. It is broadcast on the ITV network in the UK and simulcast in Ireland. «X Factor» refers to the indefinable «something» that makes for star quality. The series consists of auditions, boot camp, judges' houses, several weeks of live shows, semi-finals and the final.

<u>Ukrainian shows:</u> Master-Chef, Heads and Tails, Dancing with Stars, the Voice of the Country.

Student 1: Master-Chef is a Ukrainian competitive reality television cooking show based on the revival USA version of Master-Chef. The competition judges are Canadian-Colombian chef Hector Jimenez-Bravo, Ukrainian culinary expert Tatiana Lytvynova and Ukrainian chef Dmitry Horovenko.

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Student 2: Dancing with Stars is a dance competition show airing on 1+1 network in Ukraine. The show is based on the British television series Strictly Come Dancing. The star contestants were paired with famous Ukrainian dancers. Yuriy Horbunov and Tina Karol hosted the show.

Student 3: The Voice of the Country is a Ukrainian reality talent show that premiered on the 1+1 network on May 22, 2011. The Voice is a reality television series that features four coaches looking for a talented new artist, who could become a global superstar. The show's concept is indicated by its title: the coaches do not judge the artists by their looks, personalities, stage presence or dance routines – only their vocal ability.

Student 4: Heads and Tails is a Ukrainian television travel series that launched in 2011. It is broadcast in Ukraine and other countries. Heads and Tails is hosted by two co-hosts. In each episode, the show visits another location in the world for one weekend. One of the hosts (determined by a coin toss) receives a credit card with unlimited credit, called the Gold Card, while the other has to spend the weekend with US\$100 including all expenses. Starting with the second season, the show has hidden a bottle with \$100 in each visited location for travellers to find.
