**IN MEMORY
OF THE SON OF UKRAINE**

Bohdan Hawrylyshyn, 91, of Kyiv, Ukraine, passed away, October 24, 2016 at his home.

Bohdan was born on October 19, 1926 in the town Koropets, Ternopil region.

In 1944 during World War II, 18-year-old Bohdan was taken to Germany. In 1947 he migrated to Canada, where he was working as a logger; organized evening classes for Ukrainians and took an active part in the trade unions.

From 1952 till 1960 he held the posts in researches, engineering and management in Canada.

Since 1960, he lived in Switzerland.

Since 1988, Bohdan worked as a volunteer in Ukraine.

In 1990 he founded the International Management Institute in Kyiv.

He was a member of the Plast Organization since 1940.

In 2010 he founded «Bohdan Hawrylyshyn Foundation» aimed to train a critical mass of young Ukrainians, who experienced the best European countries' functioning and would be able to create a crucial power in transformation of Ukraine.

Bohdan Hawrylyshyn was an Honoured Scientist of Ukraine, counsel of Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, received a several honorary doctorates in Ternopil National Economic University, University named after V. Stefanyk in Ivano-Frankivsk and University of handicrafts in Chernivtsi.

Bohdan was an active editorial board member of the Journal of European Economy since the very beginning of its creation.

He is an author of over 100 scientific researches on management, economic and political environment.

The image of a patriot of his homeland will remain forever in our hearts.
