special seminars rather than lectures on general courses, using the experience of their foreign colleagues. Thus created «creative laboratory scientist» in which he gave lessons learned and research methodology to their students, creating schools and developing research areas. I. The article deals with the organization of the educational process at universities in Japan. With the improvement of the educational process at universities in Japan in the preparation of elementary school teachers recently observed trend of increasing time to the study and teaching courses on independent work. Therefore, we believe that in the course of reform in Ukraine need to use the experience of training primary school teachers in Japan.
