AUTONOMY AND LEADERSHIP IN THE EUROPEAN HIGHER

The data on the autonomy level and ranking achievements of 26 European countries' higher education institutions, including Ukrainian, are analyzed. It is confirmed that autonomy, especially academic, organizational and staffing, is an important factor in achieving top ranking positions in the "Times» and "Shanghai» rankings. However autonomy itself, not supplemented by other developed components of institution's activities, including research and innovational, does not guarantee university's competitiveness and therefore is necessary, but not sufficient, for higher school success. Autonomy synergy effect is found out; according to it integral autonomy is more effective than its differential components. It is shown that higher education in Ukraine lacks both autonomy, except staffing, as well as other key components of institution's core activities, especially research and innovational. The importance of Austrian experience concerning autonomy development and leading universities network improvement is argued taking into consideration the expediency of higher education institutions dividing only if newly created institutions are able to be top-ranked.
